Application format is attached to this mail.
3. Application should have signature of two ASI life members, One as Proposer and other as Secorder.
4. Application fees Rs. 5000 (INR Five thousand only non-refundable) should be paid online to Maharashtra State Chapter of ASIBank of Maharashtra, Karve Road, Pune branch.

5. No individual canvassing permitted by the candidates, their friends or agents. The chapter will arrange to send messages.
6. **Nominations For More Than One Of The Posts Simultaneously In The Same Election Process Will Not Be Accepted .{Rule(e)(v)}**

- Last date of withdrawal of nominations: **15.09.2026 before 5 pm**. Please note that application fees will not be refunded.

- **New EC will take over during valedictory function of MASICON 2027, Thane..**

As MASI election is conducting along with ASI national body election ,we have to follow ASI general rules for election .

As the voting is electronic, every eligible voter needs to be registered at ASI for e-voting with any approved Photo Id and should have provided mobile number and e-mail id to which alone their OTP will be sent by the system. Those who have already done the registration and participated in the elections from 2012 to 2025 will be automatically included in the registered category and can take part in the election. If there is any change in mobile number or e-mail ID that may be intimated to the Chief Election Officer with proof for appropriate correction.

Eligible voter's list as approved by the Executive committee meeting held on 30th June 2026 is uploaded at the ASI Website onth July 2026 for verification of members. If any discrepancies need to be rectified, please contact the Chief Election Officer so as to enable them to be included in the list.

Registration process for e-voting will continue till 5.30pm on 15th September 2026.

We request Members who have not registered for e-voting to please email the ASI Head Office by sending the following details before 15th September 2026.

Should there be any changes to your details registered on ASI database, please email the Chief Election Officer and the Head Office mentioning your updated details before 15th September 2026.

In accordance with our Constitution, details of registered members (email id and mobile number) on ASI electoral rolls WILL NOT be changed after 15th September 2026 for the election year 2026.

The list of Full life member from Maharashtra who are eligible to vote will be the the full life members from Maharashtra registered with ASI and eligible to vote.

Voting shall be held online. The OTP would be sent only to the registered email id and mobile number submitted by the member to ASI office. The OTP received by the member either on the mobile number or email shall not be informed or transferred to anyone.

A high resolution passport size colour photograph signed on the reverse by the candidate with name also should be sent along with the nomination form to be put up at the website.

All nomination forms shall be scrutinized and approved by the Chief Election Officer along with the election officers.

PLEASE NOTE:

Any complaints / disputes arising out of election process shall be referred to & decided by the Chief Election Officer, Election Officers & the President.

Misinformation and spreading false rumors regarding election to other contestants and voters by mail, phone or post amounts to indiscipline and is liable for appropriate action.

The decision of the Chief Election Officer with election officers & the President shall be final. No legal proceeding shall be instituted by any person outside the jurisdiction of the Chennai Civil Court regarding the election disputes. {(Rule 14(d)}

Candidates or their friends/representatives cannot send email / SMS/ WhatsApp messages to the electorate as it causes enormous disturbance to members. The Chief Election Officer will circulate the profile of every candidate to all members from his office once every week by email during the voting period.

This having stated, candidates are at liberty to call on a private note to any member in the electorate and make a campaign for his/her candidature.

Code of Conduct for Elections:

- Scientific commitments provided by candidates at the time of filing the nomination will be permitted. However, new scientific commitments (ASI-related or non-ASI-related) after filing the nomination will not be allowed.
- Bulk SMS, WhatsApp messages, social media posts or emails related to election campaigning will be considered unethical. once the nomination process starts.
- Candidates engaging in such practices will face disqualification under a zero-tolerance policy, instead of receiving warning letters.
- Non-contesting members posting election-related messages via bulk SMS, WhatsApp, social media or emails will lose their voting rights for five years.
- Candidates are permitted to make personal phone calls and send a single appeal by post as part of their election campaigning.
