The Annual General Body meeting of the Maharashtra Chapter of the Maharashtra State Chapter of Association of Surgeons of India was held on Saturday, 6th February, 2021 at 7.00 PM

Venue : Dyotan hall, MGM Medical College, Aurangabad and Virtual Platform.

Attended by 29 members physically and 15 members on virtual platform.

1. Dr. Rajendra Shinde, President of the Chapter welcomed all members and asked Secretary Dr Dharap to conduct further meeting.
2. Members reported demise of Dr Abhijeet Deshmukh, surgeon from Nagpur, Dr Manoj Jain, past EC member from Solapur and Dr Salampur, Plastic Surgeon from Amravati, Dr. R. A. Bhalerao from Mumbai and Dr, S.P. Sane from Pune and Dr. Ravindranath Tongaonkar, Dondaicha, Dhulia. One minute silence was observed in their memory.
3. Minutes of the minutes of last AGM held on 25th January 2020, at Amravati were presented, proposed by Dr. Varute, seconded by Dr Rege, passed unanimously.
4. Dr. Dharap informed the house that under the leadership of national president Dr Raghu Ram, National vice president Dr Abhay Dalvi and the state president Dr Rajendra Shinde the chapter procured PPE kits worth Rs 1728000/- and donated to various Government and Trust hospitals treating COVID-19 patients all over the state. Various city chapters undertook activities like distribution of masks and sanitizers and safety kits to front line workers and the underprivileged, conducted public awareness programmes and wrote news-paper articles highlighting the preventive precautions.
5. Travelling fellowships for 2021: Two applications were received - from Dr. Sachin Suryavanshi and Dr Pratik Biswas, Both were eligible. Dharap recommended award of Dr V R Chitale and Dr K C Gharpure to Dr Sachin Suryavanshi and Dr Pratik Biswas respectively. Approved unanimously.

6. Dr Dharap informed that 7 city chapters reported 128 (90 last year) academic and 22 (31 last year) social activities from February 2020 to January 2021. The Best Chapter award for maximum academic activities has been recommended to Association of Surgeons of Nagpur (59 activities) and the Best Chapter award for the maximum number of social activities has been recommended to the Association of Surgeons of Amravati (14 activities).
7. Dr Anand Kamat, treasurer presented the audited accounts for the year 2019-20. Proposed by Dr Patankar, seconded by Jamma, passed unanimously.
8. Dr. Kolte confirmed the location for MASICON 2022 at Pune. It was decided that as per the AGM last year, the duration of MASICON will be reduced to 3 days – Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Details to be worked out later by the new executive committee.
9. As requested by the secretary, Dr. Ganeriwal read out the constitutional amendment as passed by the executive committee. Many clauses related to membership such as annual and associate membership have been recommended for deletion in line with the parent body i.e. Association of Surgeons of India and more power has been recommended for executive committee in case of unprecedented situation like any disaster when it is not possible to hold AGM. Irrelevant clauses pertaining to journal have been recommended for deletion. It has been proposed to continue with the usual practice of election during AGM and e voting is proposed to be limited to situations when it is not possible to hold AGM. It was proposed by Dr. Pravin Suryavanshi, seconded by Dr. Munot and was passed unanimously.
10. As requested by the Election officer Dr Gode, on behalf him, Dr Dharap, announced the election results and read out the names of the elected members: Dr Sameer Rege for Secretary, Dr Anjali Dawle for treasurer, Dr Kedar Patil from Pune and Dr. Udaysingh More from Nanded region were declared elected by virtue of winning majority votes in the election. Dr. Kishore Adhyanthaya, Dr. Rajan Relekar, Dr. Upendra Talathi, Dr. Mansingh Rao Ghatge, Dr. Ashok Dhonde, Dr. Sachin Jamma, Dr. Snehal Fegade, Dr. Nandkishor Katore, Dr. Vikas Deshmukh, Dr. Jayshree Ingole, Dr. Ravindra Telkar, Dr. Atish Bansod and Dr. Vikas Jain were elected unopposed.
11. Dr Patankar asked clarification on the objections raised by any member about the election. Dr Dharap informed that an e mail has been sent by Dr Anand Kamat to Dr Gode in which had expressed dissatisfaction with the conduct of elections. However, Dr Kamat agreed to withdraw the complaint as requested by Dr Patankar and other senior members; It was appreciated by the house amidst loud applause.
