Dr. V. N. Shrikhande, an esteemed surgeon, philosopher, visionary leader, and revered teacher, has left for the heavenly abode, leaving an indelible mark on the world of medicine and on all who knew him. His unwavering dedication to his patients and to the advancement of surgical practices earned him respect and admiration from colleagues, students and patients alike.

Dr. Shrikhande was renowned for his pioneering work in surgical gastroenterology. His decades-long career, contributed immensely to the field, blending innovation with compassionate care. One of his innovative technique which he popularised in the early 70's, 'Re-anastomosis of Vas' gave hopes to many couples. His expertise, meticulous technique, and commitment to excellence set a high standard in surgical practice and patient care, and he was known as much for his kindness as for his skill. Those fortunate to work alongside him remember his mentorship, his dedication to continuous learning, and his ability to inspire those around him.

I was fortunate enough to work with him at Shrikhande clinic Dadar. Like many of his students I learnt many nuances of life other than just surgery. Humanity, kindness, a nationalist to the core,
